**Allagash White, Portland, Maine**

**Lagunitas Dog Town Pale Ale, Petaluma, California**

A delicious pale ale from this highly esteemed west coast brewer (with Illinois roots). Nice citrus, good hops, great malt balance and a very smooth finish. More character than many other pale ale's we've tried. 6.4% ABV.



**Negra Modelo, Mexico**

Better known as the "cream of beer", Negra Modelo was first sold in Mexico as a draft beer in 1926. Negra Modelo, a Munich-style beer, was first exported to the States at the beginning of the 1980s and has become internationally renowned. This malty beer with a slightly bitter finish is a great summer lager, no lime required...



**Trumer Pils, Berkeley, California**

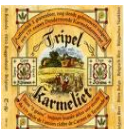
Here's another great one from our neighbors in Michigan.



**Old Rasputin Russian Imperial Stout, North Coast Brewing, CA**

**Tripel Karmeliet, Brouwerij Bosteels, Buggenhout, Belgium**

This is one of our favorite Belgians. Blond, robust, smooth, and fruity three grain top-fermented beer. Brewed from the original 1679 recipe after Karmeliet tradition with wheat, oats and barley. Everything about this gem, even down to the glassware, suggests royalty. 8% ABV



**Stella Artois, Leuven, Belgium**

**Great Lakes Brewing Co. "Seasonal", Cleveland, Ohio**

**Stone Brewery "Levitation", Escondido, California**
