



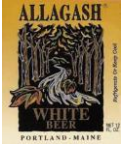

**The Bank Restaurant Bail Out Ale, Warrenville, Illinois (abv 5.1%)**

Enjoy light beer? Support your local economy! Belgian malt saaz and goldings hops leaves other domestic lights sadly lacking. This light ale will quench your thirst but still leave you ready for more. Brewed next door by our friends at Two Brother's Brewery in Warrenville.

**Allagash White, Portland, Maine (abv 5%)**

If you are a fan of Blue Moon you just may fall in love all over again. This cloudy gem with a gentle pepper backing could make your switch permanent.

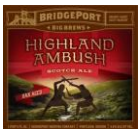

**Bell's Oberon Ale, Kalamazoo, Michigan (abv 5.8%)**

Here's another great one from our neighbors in Michigan.

**Bridgeport Highland Ambush Scottish Ale, Portland, Oregon (abv 6.8%)**

First brewed in the 1980s as a special beer for the BrewPub at BridgePort, Highland Ambush is making its triumphant return more than 20 years later. This year's Highland Ambush takes inspiration from the original ale using NW pale ale malt along with a Scottish crystal and roast malt.

**Brooklyn IPA, Brooklyn, New York (abv 6.8%)**

Traditionally dry-hopped for a bright aroma of hops, lemongrass, pine and citrus fruit. A robust bitterness and warming malt palate lead to a clean hoppy finish.

**Guinness, Dublin, Ireland (abv 4.1%)**

It takes about 119.5 seconds to pour the perfect pint. But don't fret. It's worth the wait.

**Hacker-Pschorr, Munich, Germany (abv 6.8%)**

Hacker-Pschorr Weisse is a wheat beer from Bavaria that offers a refreshing taste for those who enjoy real beer. It has a mildly fruity taste and cloudy golden color.

**Magic Hat #9, South Burlington, Vermont (abv 5.1%)**

An ale whose mysterious and unusual palate will swirl across your tongue and ask more questions than it answers. A sort of dry, crisp, refreshing, not-quite pale ale.

**Matilda, Chicago, Illinois (abv 7%)**

This Belgian style pale ale made by Goose Island is wild in character, with a slightly fruity aroma and a spicy yeast flavor.

**Smithwick's, Kilkenny, Ireland (abv 5%)**

Ireland's number one ale. Exceptional taste, color and purity of ingredients make it truly unique.

**Spaten Lager, Munich, Germany (abv 5.2%)**

In 1894 Spaten became the first brewery in Munich to produce this brand of light lager. Golden in color with a well-balanced hop-flavor this beer delivers a delicate balance of hops and malty sweetness.

**Stella Artois, Leuven, Belgium (abv 5.2%)**

Only the very best barley and the finest hops. Full bodied and exceptionally well-balanced.

**Bosteels Triple Karmeliet, Buggenhout, Belgium (abv 8%)**

This is one of our favorite Belgians. Blond, robust, smooth, and fruity three grain top-fermented beer. Brewed from the original 1679 recipe after Karmeliet tradition with wheat, oats and barley.

**Trumer Pils, Berkeley, California (abv 4.8%)**
